



AUSTRALIAN AIR FORCE CADETS
CONDITIONS OF UNIFORM ISSUE

All members are entitled to a uniform in accordance with the appropriate scale of issue. Not all items are available at all times and may be issued after enrolment. Not all items are new but must be of an acceptable standard at the time of issue. The issued items are recorded on the member's personal clothing card which is held electronically in the Cadet Logistics System (C-LOG).

All clothing is to be maintained by the member in a clean state, correctly fitting and fit for wear as a military style uniform throughout the period of enrolment. It is acknowledged that clothing items may become unserviceable through fair wear and tear, accidental damage, size adjustment or may be lost or stolen and accordingly there are exchange and re-issue processes.

All uniform items remain the property of the Commonwealth and on discharge from Cadet service must be returned in clean, serviceable condition with the exception of; pre-worn footwear, socks & hat .Issued ID card must be returned with uniforms.
